

BY THE NUMBERS

This chart indicates the average number of applicants each year alongside the average number of students accepted into each program.

Applicants may apply to a maximum of $\underline{3}$ programs. If offered admission to any programs, please notify program coordinators as soon as possible of your choice so those placed on the waiting list can be notified of the change in their admission statuses.

Remember, each program is a four-year commitment. Due to capacity limitations and program requirements, students cannot change programs. If a student no longer wishes to participate in a Magnet, he/she will withdrawal and return to his/her community school.

7. TEACHER ENDORSEMENTS

HCPS students will be asked to select teachers from a pull down menu. If two teachers are given, choose one.

- Regardless of program choice, each of your teachers will only need to fill out <u>one</u> recommendation form.
- Once your teacher has submitted a recommendation, it is applicable for all programs.

Non-HCPS students will download the endorsement forms and email them to appropriate middle school teachers to complete. Completed forms must be <u>emailed</u> to each Program Specialist(s) for the program(s) to which you are applying. Email addresses are on page 4 of this booklet and on the endorsement form.

- Next, you will be asked to submit your <u>ACTIVITY LIST</u>. This can be done now or at a later time, but NOT later than December 1, 2020. Your application will not be considered until this step has been completed.
 - This list only needs to be submitted <u>once</u> and is active for all programs to which you apply.
 - Please provide information in the form of a BULLETED LIST.
 - Once you have submitted your Activity List, you cannot go back to change it!.
- You will also be asked to write an essay for each of the programs you apply to. You may complete this now, or at a later time, but NOT later than December 1, 2020.
 - Your application will not be considered until this step has been completed.
 - Once you have submitted your essay, you cannot go back to change it!
- 10. Click "Submit Application." You may then return to the Home Page to apply to another program.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- *You can log into your account at any time until December 1st to review your application.
- *There is a place on the website, within your account, for you to withdraw your application to a particular program if you change your mind.
- * Remember to contact your school counselor if you need additional assistance.

GUIDE TO THE ONLINE APPLICATION

I. Go to www.hcps.org

On the left side of the screen click on Schools > Magnet Programs > Application or visit www.hcps.org/magnetprograms/

First time users - "Click Here to Register"

- Choose your middle school from the pull down menu or "other" if you are not currently a student in a Harford County public middle school.
 - Fill in the required information to setup your account.
 - Double-check your typing to ensure 100% accuracy!!
 - An email will arrive with your temporary password.
 - You will be sent back to the main log on screen to continue.
 - Log on with your ID and temporary password you will be prompted to change your password to something you can <u>easily</u> <u>remember</u>. You will need this information to log into your account at any time in the future!!
- 3. Once you have all the information you need, click "To Apply for Admission to a Magnet Program."
- 4. Read the Application Policy with your parent(s). Both statements at the end must be checked before you can continue.
- 5. For HCPS students, your information will appear. If everything is correct, click "Continue Application." If you need to make corrections, click "Edit my Information."

For non-HCPS students, please enter <u>all</u> requested information.

- 6. You may apply to a maximum of <u>3</u> HCPS magnet programs. Each application must be completed individually. Note:
 - For Harford Tech choose ONE technical program
 - For NRAS choose your pathways in order of preference

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

These minimum criteria are evaluated during initial screenings of each Magnet Program applicant. Beyond these, each program uses additional evaluation and screenings during the months of January and February to determine and admission status of each applicant. You will receive further information from each Program Specialist as appropriate.

I. Academic achievement in middle school, to include:

- Grades
- Standardized test scores
- Scholastic Reading Index (SRI)/Lexile scores

2. Demonstrated interest and motivation for learning:

- Report card comments
- Teacher endorsements
- School and community involvement (Activity List)

3. Written communication skills

Written essay(s)

Additional, program-specific requirements:

Global Studies/International Baccalaureate

- Successful completion of Algebra I prior to entering program.
- Strongly recommend successful completion of Geometry.

Harford Technical High School

- Regular attendance.
- Consideration for honors placement is based on 7th/8th grade standardized test scores and HTHS placement testing.
- Consideration for Advanced Placement is based on middle school teacher's recommendation.

Information Technology Oracle Academy

Natural Resources and Agricultural Sciences

Algebra I recommended, not required.

Science and Mathematics Academy

Successful completion of Algebra 1 and *Geometry prior to entering the program.

*Geometry may be taken during the summer before ninth grade.

Pathways in Technology Early College High School

• No additional requirements at this time.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

I. Where should I turn in my application?

- Applications for all students will be submitted online.
- For non-HCPS students, middle school transcripts and test scores must be sent to the Program Specialist at <u>each</u> program to which you apply.
- If in the process of moving, you must be a resident of Harford County when school starts. Proof of residency will be required when registering.

2. What about teacher endorsement forms?

- For HCPS students, this process is completed electronically.
- For non-HCPS students, teacher endorsement forms must be downloaded and emailed to current middle school teachers (as noted on the form).
 Completed endorsements should then be emailed to the appropriate Program Specialist for each magnet program. Email information for each Program Specialist is on page 4 of this booklet.

3. Can I fax my application or letters of recommendation? No.

4. Can I apply to more than one magnet program?

Yes, you may apply to a maximum of 3 programs. *You may apply to only one program at Harford Technical High School; multiple applications to different technical programs, from the same student, are <u>not</u> accepted.

5. How do I know if my application has been received?

Please note all important communication from Harford County Public Schools, and from the Program Specialist at each Magnet Program, will come to you via **EMAIL**. It is imperative you enter a functioning, frequently checked, and correctly typed email address on the application; the parent's and the student's emails are strongly encouraged on the application. The following information is relayed to applicants and parent(s) via email:

- I. Initial acknowledgment for receipt of application:
- 2. Periodic updates regarding evaluation and screening of the application;
- 3. Notifications regarding further assessment/testing; and
- 4. Notification of admission status throughout the admissions process.

Notification will be sent via the email addresses provided on the application. Set your email to accept correspondence from webmaster@hcps.org. In addition, allow your email to accept messages from the appropriate Program Specialist(s) noted on pages 3 & 4 of this booklet. This will prevent your SPAM filter from automatically deleting these emails.

6. How will I find out about transportation?

7. Can I still be involved in sports, drama, music, and extracurriculars?

Yes, you have the opportunity to participate in any and all activities offered at your Magnet school.

8. How can I improve my chances of acceptance to a magnet program?

Make sure the complete application is submitted on time and you are putting forth your best effort in middle school.

9. What if I have not been enrolled in a Harford County public middle school for ALL or part of grades 6, 7, and/or 8?

Parent(s) will send <u>all</u> transcript information from the school/setting outside of HCPS, directly to the appropriate Program Specialist(s).

10. I receive accommodations through an IEP or 504 Plan. Am I eligible?

It is the policy of HCPS to afford equal opportunity in education to all students. Students receiving Special Education services or who have a 504 Plan are given the same consideration in the selection process as all other students.

11. I am on Home/Hospital teaching. Am I eligible?

You may still apply. Choose your assigned middle school on the application.

12. I need help with the application process. Where can I get help?

- Refer to our "Guide to the Online Application" on the next page.
- See your School Counselor for help; you may also contact the appropriate Program Specialist.

13. What if I change my mind and want to withdraw my application to a program?

This can be completed on-line through the application website.

14. If I am accepted and end up not liking the program, can I switch?

Due to seat capacity and programmatic requirements, students are not permitted to change magnet programs, but may elect to discontinue the magnet program and return to their community school. Magnet Programs are a 4-year commitment.
